## Membership Conditions

(Refer to By-laws and Rules in NMRR Timetable for complete membership rules and responsibilities)

**ELIGIBILITY FOR MEMBERSHIP** – Membership is open to any person.

### CLASSIFICATION OF MEMBERS

- A. REGULAR MEMBERS must be at least 18 years of age.
- B. AFFILIATE MEMBERS must be sponsored by a Regular Member
- C. BUSINESS MEMBERS
- D. HONORARY MEMBERS

### RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- A. Pay dues as specified and in a timely manner.
- B. Adhere to Club Rules.
- C. Attend Club meetings and other functions.
- D. Participate in and promote Club goals and activities.
- E. Vote on Club business (Regular Members only)
- F. Accept “Majority Rule” of the Club Membership.
- G. Cooperate with others.
- H. Conduct him/herself honestly, respecting others rights
- I. Express opinions, support, and opposition to Club activities, policies, or goals in a timely manner.
- J. From time to time, host Club Meetings (Regular Members).
- K. Perform assigned or volunteered duties and tasks.

**APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP** – Application for Regular Membership shall be made by payment of dues and New Member Fees as specified in Club Rules.

**ADVANCEMENT OF AFFILIATE MEMBERS TO REGULAR MEMBERSHIP** – Affiliate Members may advance to regular membership, subject to the requirements contained elsewhere, without going through the normal probationary period. Affiliate members advancing to regular membership are required to pay New Member fees equal to the difference between current affiliate and regular Member new member fees.

**SUSPENSION/DISMISSAL** – Members who have not paid annual dues within two calendar months of the due date are subject to automatic suspension. Members in chronic or flagrant violation of Club rules or who have not fulfilled Responsibilities of Members as detailed previously are subject to dismissal at the option of the Board, subject to simple majority approval of the Regular Membership present at a Business Meeting.

**CLUB RESPONSIBILITY** – The Club shall not be responsible for:

- A. The property of Members or visitors left inadvertently or deliberately at any Club Meeting, function, or event.
- B. Property donated to the Club by Members or visitors.
- C. Damage caused to the belongings of Members or visitors while attending Club meetings or activities.
- D. Injury to any Member, visitor, or guest that is due to negligence on the part of the injured person.

**LOG** - A log shall be maintained at all Club meetings and work sessions. All Members shall sign in and must sign in any visitors they may bring.

**SECURITY** - Members entrusted with Club property shall ensure it is properly secured before departing the area.

**CLEANLINESS AND SAFETY** - Each Regular Member shall maintain the cleanliness of his or her area of activity as well as the general cleanliness of any area of Club activity. Each member shall be alert to potential safety hazards posted by the Club’s activities and take prudent action to correct them.

**DUES** - Dues are payable at the beginning of the fiscal year. Dues may be paid on a annual or semi-annual basis in April and October.

**INTOXICANTS** - No intoxicants are permitted at Club or Board meetings, Club sanctioned work sessions, or at public shows.

**PERSONAL CONDUCT** - All Members shall conduct himself / herself so as to not bring discredit upon the Club or to model railroading in general. Profane speech, offensive gestures, clothing, or other items having inflammatory, vulgar, or otherwise objectionable words, illustrations or marking are discouraged at Club activities and **will not** be tolerated at public shows.

### MODULE SPECIFICATIONS

- A. All modules must meet NTRAK specifications.
- B. The Club has adopted the alternate (10”) location for “Branch Line”.
- C. Each standard module (or group) must have two “C” clamps.
- D. Each module owner shall provide a drape.
